### INTERNATIONAL RESEARCH SEMINAR

THE 2010 NPT REVIEW CONFERENCE ACTION PLAN: IMPLEMENTATION AND OPERATIONALIZATION

-PEACEFUL USES OF NUCLEAR ENERGY
(GCSP, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Jura Room, 30 June 2011)

## **RATIONALE**

The 2010 Review Conference of the Non-proliferation Treaty (NPT) adopted in its a final document an Action Plan containing 64 actions (plus the Middle East resolution) in order to implement the obligations contained in the three "pillars" of the NPT (nuclear disarmament, nuclear non-proliferation and peaceful uses of nuclear energy). As part of a multi-year project supported by the Swiss Government and the Geneva Branch of the United Nations Office for Disarmament Affairs, a first seminar is organised on the peaceful uses of nuclear energy, to be followed by further ones on nuclear non-proliferation and disarmament. The issue of nuclear safety will take a prominent place in the discussion following the Fukushima catastrophe.

#### **AIMS**

This seminar aims at:

- Providing a platform for examining the degree of implementation and operationalization of the Action Plan in one of the three NPT "pillars", and
- Proposing concrete actions and initiatives for the NPT Review process, or advances in the areas where insufficient progress was reported.

It is intended to provide interested stakeholders opportunities to express their views, share information, and seek common solutions. The results of those discussions will be made public by the organisers.

## **DOCUMENTATION**

This seminar will be have been prepared by two **background papers** assessing the implementation of the Action Plan in the relevant "pillar" in order to steer the discussion:

- Reaching Critical Will (RCW) will have produced a monitoring report ahead of the seminar, including a factual overview of the relevant actions and concrete implementation measures taken by relevant states in line with the Action Plan.
- The second background document will be an assessment analytical paper authored by an
  invited specialised expert (in this case Mr Bruno Pellaud, former Deputy Director-General of the
  International Atomic Energy Agency IAEA), containing evaluation of policies and fulfilment of
  commitments, as well as recommendations.
