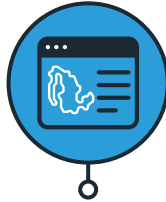
## An interactive guide and confidence-building tool for policymakers

Individual profiles summarise and link key cyber strategy documents, agencies, legislation and multilateral agreements.



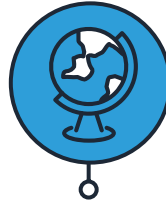
Allows easy gap analysis of progress in selected criteria across states and regions.
